Dear Parishioners

The November issue of Tui Motu reflects on life's inevitable changes with Mike Riddell suggesting that Western culture has developed a remedy for death - denial. This is found in the common refusal to adopt the language of death: *if we don't mention it, perhaps it will leave us alone*. In any number of meetings I have had with families to prepare funeral liturgies, the majority refer to their loved one as having *passed away* or some similar phrase; the reality through is that they have *died*.

When we use words other than *death* or *dying* we look to be in denial. Many fear death and are fearful of non-existence and/or the unknown. This can result in an inability to live our lives to that fullness desired by God and we become thwarted from our natural tendencies to mourn.

Death is an essential part of life: once we accept this as reality, we will be able to trust God.
