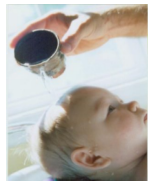

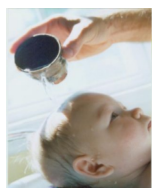


Our Lady of Kāpiti welcomes
