Let's not be like the self-centered Pharisee in today's Gospel. He prays by telling God how wonderful he is and passing judgment on others. He's not praying for his community, the needy, sick, sinners or outcasts.

On Mission Sunday we remember and assist financially missionary work in developing countries. Sister Dorothy Dickson is one of three Mission Sisters working in South Sudan and she presents a graphic description of what is happening there right now.
