Dear Parishioners,

Over the past few days we have celebrated the Feasts of All Saints and Holy Souls.....but did you know how these originated?

1st Nov. This feast began in the East in the eighth century to commemorate all martyrs and was progressively adopted in the West. So honoured on the 1st November are all men and women in glory with Christ, known or unknown, mighty or lowly, whose lives were modelled on the gospel and the great commandment of love.

2nd Nov. This began early in the Middle Ages as an annual prayer day for the dead. It spread more widely after the tenth century and was given the name Holy Souls. It is now one of our main liturgical feasts. It expresses our faith in the Communion of Saints and our need to pray for each other. So let us pray especially this month for all those who have gone before us, for however they may have lived, they are all Holy Souls, and know that in the kingdom of heaven they too are praying for us.
