**Dear Parishioners,**

'Jesus is what we are called to be. But, of course, we draw back and resist, because we get scared. Sunday's Gospel lets us watch this happen when Jesus brought the Good News to his own neighbourhood. At first the people were fascinated by him, but then many of them, his family included, got frightened and resisted and called him crazy. You see, they liked the illusion they were living in, where salvation could be won by external compliance with rules. It didn't really work. But they dreaded having to look inside and wrestle with the big things that make us God-like. So they found an excuse, "Jesus, you must be crazy, or maybe you're possessed by devils." And with that excuse many of them held him at arm's length, and kept him on the outside of their lives.

The Lord will never leave us. He'll never cease knocking at our inner door, urging us to let him in, and to let one another in. That means it's a real possibility that any number of us will go through the whole of life never having really known or loved ourselves, our God, or even one of our neighbours. Will that happen to us? Will we settle for impoverishing our inside by living only on the outside? The decision is ours, and we get to make part of that decision this very day. What will it be?
